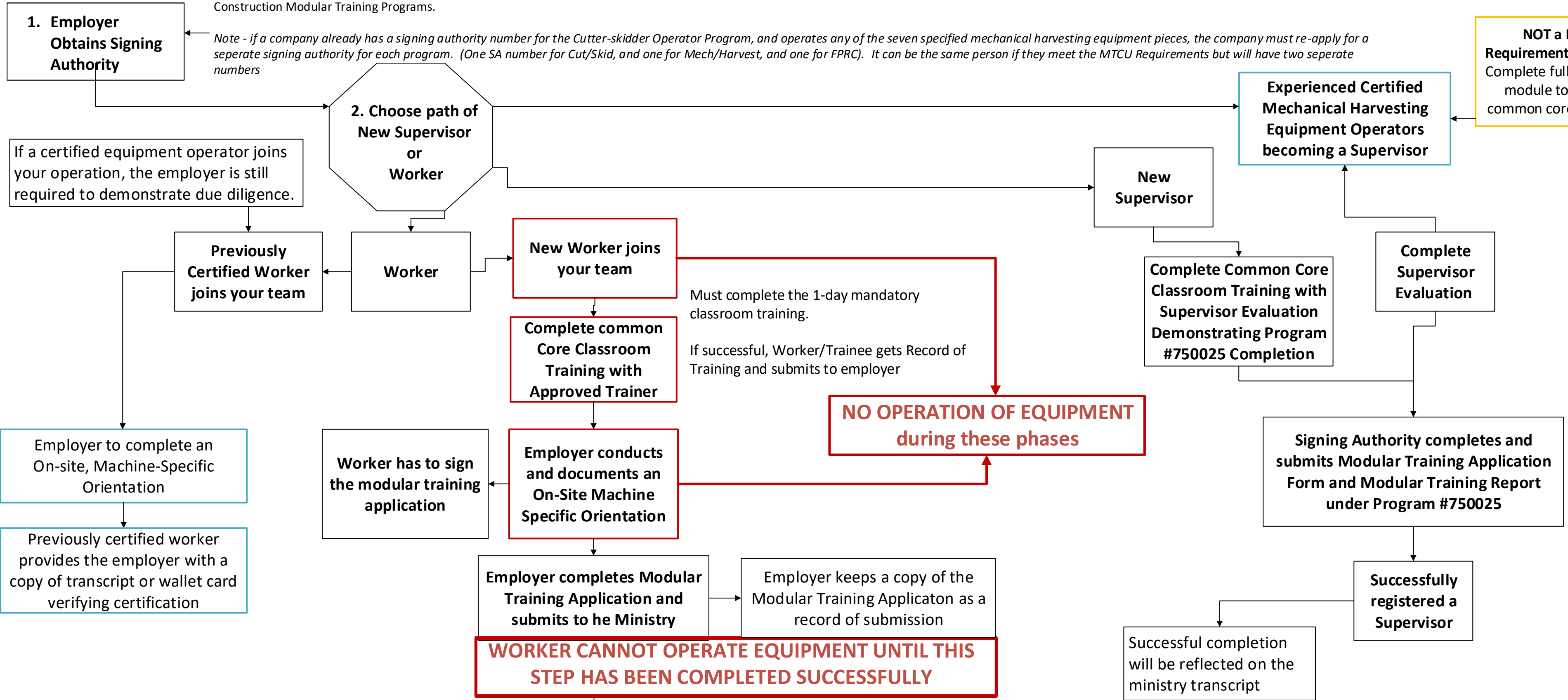


Signing Authority is obtained by contacting your local MTCU office. A company will be issued one signing authority number for the Mechanical Harvesting Equipment Operator and/or Forestry Pit and Road Construction Modular Training Programs.

Note - if a company already has a signing authority number for the Cutter-skidder Operator Program, and operates any of the seven specified mechanical harvesting equipment pieces, the company must re-apply for a separate signing authority for each program. (One SA number for Cut/Skid, and one for Mech/Harvest, and one for FPRC). It can be the same person if they meet the MTCU Requirements but will have two separate numbers

NOT a Legal Requirement, Optional:

On-the-Job Training with a certified mechanical harvesting equipment operator or a competent supervisor can start.
Operator must be trained and evaluated within 12 months of submitting the modular training application to the Ministry (for each piece of equipment they are to operate).

Scheduled evaluation will be completed within 12 months of submitting modular training application.
Evaluator must be an MHEO Approved trainer/evaluator

The Modular Training Standards book is signed by the worker, the supervisor, the Approved Trainer/Evaluator, and the Signing Authority, verifying successful completion of each modular training standard; it remains the property of the worker.

The Ministry will issue a wallet card to the worker upon successful completion of the machine-specific MH/FPRCEO program certification requirements. (Repeat all steps for accreditation specific to each machine.)
