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Eligibility

Ideally, we are seeking candidates that represent our primary sectors (mining, forestry, pulp and paper, printing and converting) in both worker and management roles.

Four Board of Director positions for a combination of two and three-year terms (November 2021 – November 2023 or 2024).

We are further seeking candidates with experience in one or more of the following areas:

- financial/accounting;
- legal;
- human resources;
- information technology;
- serving on not-for-profit boards;
- government relations;
- occupational health and safety.

Choosing to invest your time and experience with the WSN Board of Directors is rewarding and will provide an invaluable leadership opportunity to the right volunteers. The role provides companies with a unique opportunity to influence and raise the profile of prevention as a centerpiece for any corporate social responsibility program.

Qualifications

Each Director shall:

- be at the date of his/her election and thereafter remain throughout his/her term, a Member of the Corporation;
- be at least eighteen (18) years of age;
- not be an undischarged bankrupt;
- be and remain in compliance with the Corporation's Code of Ethics and the Conflict of Interest Policy; and
- fulfill the competency requirements for Board membership as determined and set out by the Nominating and Recruitment Committee.

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Attributes

Candidates should demonstrate the following attributes:

- Integrity and high ethical standards;
- Intellectual capacity for conceptual and strategic thinking;
- Ability to cut through complex issues and ask incisive questions;
- Independent judgment;
- Candour and the willingness to table difficult issues;
- Willingness to act on and be accountable for decisions;
- The interpersonal skills to work collegially within and outside WSN, and to express views in a way that is both challenging and supportive; and
- Commitment to prepare for and attend meetings on a regular basis.

Time Commitment

- Commits to attending all Board meetings, sub-committee meetings and a Board orientation meeting for new directors.
 - The Board meetings are scheduled from 8:00 a.m. – 12:00 p.m. (4 hours each, typically four meetings annually)
 - The Sub-committee meetings are scheduled from 8:30 a.m. – 10 a.m. (1.5 hours each, typically three meetings annually). Specific sub-committees may host special meetings to address pressing matters.

Please note: Preparation time is not included. All documents will be available five days in advance of the meetings.
