Sudbury, April 21-23, 2020

The annual Mining Health and Safety Conference welcomes more than 300 attendees each year. Delegates gather to learn and share their knowledge about mining health and safety, and network with industry professionals.

Key areas of focus for presentations include research and innovation, safety culture and management systems, workplace well-being and mental health, hazards specific to underground work, and emergency preparedness and mine rescue.
